

**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF BROWNSTOWN
BEAUTIFICATION / HISTORICAL COMMISSION
July 17, 2018**

The regular meeting of the Charter Township of Brownstown Beautification/Historical Commission was held at the Brownstown Community Center, 21311 Telegraph Road, on Tuesday, July 17, 2018. The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Galik at 7:00 p.m., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

MINUTE APPROVAL: Motion of Walters, supported by Ptasznki, to approve the Beautification/Historical meeting minutes of June 19, 2018. All present voting aye.

AGENDA APPROVAL: Motion of Ptasznki, supported by Walters, to approve the Beautification/Historical Commission agenda of July 17, 2018, as submitted. All present voting aye.

HISTORICAL SOCIETY REPORT: The Historical Society will be participating with the DDA for Kids Day on August 1st. They will have an activity for the kids to do outside the Historical Museum. August 22nd will be the Annual Garden Party at the Event Center. There will be music and food provided by the Beautification/Historical Commission and Historical Society.

2018 PROJECTS: The Beautification committee sent a press release on July 10th for the Beautification Award contest. After discussion, it was decided that the Beautification Award Yard Sign would have the year printed on them and the window decals would not. Also, corrugated plastic will be used when designing the signs, keeping cost down and allowing for multiple signs to be awarded and for winners to keep sign. The cutoff date to nominate for the Beautification Award is August 10th and notifications to owners will be sent on August 15th. The next Beautification/Historical Commission meeting will be held on August 21st and will take place on the Senior/Recreation bus in route to the nominated homes and businesses of Brownstown, where judging will take place.

OTHER BUSINESS: Looking ahead, newsletter will be going out regarding Halloween decorating contest. Recreation Director Maxe is currently looking for new commissioner to fill vacant seat on the Beautification/Historical Commission. Historical Society Commission has addressed the need for some maintenance on historical St. Mary's site. This site has been added to the townships regular lawn mowing schedule.
