PARK DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS:

TOWNSHIP CAMPUS DEVELOPMENT: Director Maxe, reported to members that contracts have been awarded and work has begun on the new softball diamonds north of King Road. DTE electrical trenching has started and softball diamonds are expected to be completed by Sept. 15th. Diamonds should be playable for Spring 2019.

Director Maxe, reported to members that the Splashpad surface re-coating was completed and the Splashpad opened for the 2018 season on Saturday, May 26th for the Memorial Day weekend. Since the Splashpad opened there have been several days that the splashpad has been closed due to varying temperatures below 70*.

2018 SUMMER PROGRAMS: Newsletters were mailed to all residents and flyers have been distributed to schools. A summary of registrations to date is attached. Summer swim program was full so an earlier class at 9:15 a.m., for Groups A and B have been added to help accomodate those on the waiting list.

Member Wheaton, asked Director Maxe, if it was possible to have pickle ball courts put in with the existing tennis courts. Director Maxe, stated the tennis instructor had mentioned something to him about it also, so he will look into it.
