



Important Election Message for Voters at:
HUNTER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL (Precincts 6 & 7) and
CARLSON HIGH SCHOOL (Precincts 8 & 11)

Schools within the Gibraltar School District will remain open during the March 10 Presidential Primary Election.

The Brownstown Clerk's office is working with the school district to ensure voters at Hunter Elementary School and Carlson High School have easy access to the polls, while still maintaining the security of students.

Here are some tips to help you on Election Day:

- Be aware that there will be increased school traffic for short periods of time during student "drop off" and "pick up" times.
- At both locations, there will be increased signage and police presence to help direct voters to the proper location and ensure everyone's safety.

HUNTER ELEMENTARY (Precincts 6 & 7)

Reserved parking for voters is available in the West Parking Lot (nearest to I-75).

Voters will enter the gymnasium directly from this lot.



CARLSON HIGH SCHOOL (Precincts 8 & 11)

Reserved parking for voters is available on the West Side (backside) of the gymnasium.

Voters will enter the gymnasium directly from this lot.

Voters are encouraged to utilize the Shumate Middle School driveway (furthest north driveway) to enter off of West Jefferson Ave. This will assist you in avoiding high traffic areas since school is in session.
