Dear Property Owner,

Over a year ago, the Township held meetings regarding the conditions of the roads within Flowers Creek Subdivision. At those meetings, various cost and potential solutions were discussed. The Township performed a PASER study to present the facts to Wayne County of the need for additional funding through its Local Road Initiative program. Since meeting with the residents, we have met several times with Wayne County for over a year. Last week, we were informed that Wayne County has agreed to provide additional funding for Flowers Creek. The Township will receive an additional \$500,000 plus the Township will provide the twenty percent match for your roads.

The Township has hired GV Cement of Brownstown Township, Michigan to provide street patching and joint sealing work within your neighborhood. The work will consist of removing and replacing deteriorated areas of concrete, adjusting storm drains as needed and joint sealing control joints for preventive measures. The work will be performed in the areas of roadway that were rated worse from the PASER rating which was performed last fall. The work will take place on Curt Drive, Gloria Drive, Charles Drive, Gregory Street, Stacey Drive, Brentwood Drive and Emily Drive. The contract will commence the week of September 18th with saw cutting and removal and replacement of concrete thereafter. It is anticipated the work will last up to six weeks. We will be removing half of the street at a time to allow for access during construction. Existing driveways will remain with access unless the patch in front of the driveway requires removal then access will be restricted for five days.

We ask that while traveling the roads please be cautious and kind as there will be men and women working in tight conditions. Safety of the workers is important to all.
