

NOTICE to the electors of the CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF BROWNSTOWN
Election to be held on AUGUST 7, 2018
ONE POSITION OF TRUSTEE on the BOARD OF TRUSTEES
Partial Term: November 20, 2018 to November 20, 2020

To the qualified Electors of the Charter Township of Brownstown, County of Wayne, notice is hereby given that an election is to be held for a partial term for the position of Trustee on the Board of Trustees of the Charter Township of Brownstown. A candidate who wishes to seek the position is required by law to file nominating petitions and a notarized Affidavit of Identity. The partisan nominating petitions shall contain a minimum of 50; and a maximum of 100 valid signatures of township electors to qualify for placement on the primary ballot (MCL 168.544f).

Candidates can pick up the nominating petitions, affidavit of identity form and candidate information at the Township Clerk's office during regular business hours. The completed petitions are required to be submitted to the **Township Clerk** prior to **4:00 p.m. Tuesday, April 24, 2018. Petitions submitted or received after the deadline of 4:00 p.m. April 24th will NOT be accepted.**

To be eligible for election to a township office, a person must be a United States citizen, a registered and qualified elector of Brownstown Township by the filing deadline of April 24, 2018 (MCL 168.342) and has lived at least 30 days in Brownstown Township. A person who has been convicted of a violation of Section 12a of 1941 PA 370, MCL 38.412a, shall not be eligible for election to a township office for a period of 20 years after conviction. (MCL 168.342)
