ORDINANCE NO. 313

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT MARIHUANA ESTABLISHMENTS
PURSUANT TO THE MICHIGAN REGULATION AND
TAXATION OF MARIHUANA ACT

The Charter Township of Brownstown ordains:


Section 1. Prohibition of Marihuana Establishments.

Pursuant to the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act Section 6.1, the Township elects to prohibit marihuana establishments within its boundaries.

Section 2. Severability. If any article, section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity of such article, section, paragraph, clause, or provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 3. Repealer. All ordinances, resolutions or orders, or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed. Nothing in this Ordinance results in any prohibition otherwise allowed under the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act, as adopted.

Section 4. Effective Date; Publication. This Ordinance was approved and adopted by the Township Board of Brownstown Charter Township, Wayne County, Michigan, on June 3, 2019, after introduction and a first reading on May 6, 2019, and publication after first reading as required by Act 359 of the Michigan Public Acts of 1947, as amended. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon publication, in The News Herald, a newspaper having general circulation in the Township.


