PRIMARY ELECTION OF AUGUST 7, 2018

LAST DAY TO REGISTER

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the State Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, August 7, 2018. The last day on which persons may register with the appropriate City/Township Clerk to be eligible to vote at the foresaid election, is **MONDAY, JULY 9, 2018**. If you currently are not registered to vote or have changed your address, you may do so in the following manner:

In Person:

- At your City/Township Clerk's Office or at the Wayne County Clerk's Office during their normal business hours Monday through Friday.
- At any Secretary of State Branch offices located throughout the state during normal business hours.
- At the specified agency for clients receiving services through the Family Independence Agency, the Department of Community Health, Michigan Jobs Commission and some offices of the Commission for the Blind.
- At the military recruitment offices for persons enlisting in the armed forces.

By Mail:

- By obtaining and completing a Mail-In Voter Registration Application and forwarding it to the election official as directed on the application by the close of registration deadline. Mail-In voter registration applications may be obtained from the Department of State website at www.michigan.gov/sos or by contacting your local Clerk's Office.

QUALIFICATIONS: A citizen of the United States and resident of the City/Township, who is at least 18 years of age and has lived in the State of Michigan, resident of the City/Township for at least 30 days prior to Monday, July 9, 2018.

The last day to register to vote for the State Primary Election is Monday, July 9, 2018.
